

# Things to Remember

- Always carry your boat registration card when operating a boat.
- Keep your boat registration current. You can now renew online! **[www.tpwd.state.tx.us/boatregistration](http://www.tpwd.state.tx.us/boatregistration)**
- By law, boats and outboard motors must be titled.
- Don't buy a boat or motor from someone who isn't the titled owner.
- Don't sell a boat or motor that's not titled in your name.
- The seller must provide a detailed bill of sale.
- **Clean your boat, trailer and gear of all plant and animal material before you leave the lake.**  
Transportation of prohibited invasive plants is punishable by up to a \$500 fee per violation. If you see someone transporting prohibited plants, call 1 (800) 793-4263.
