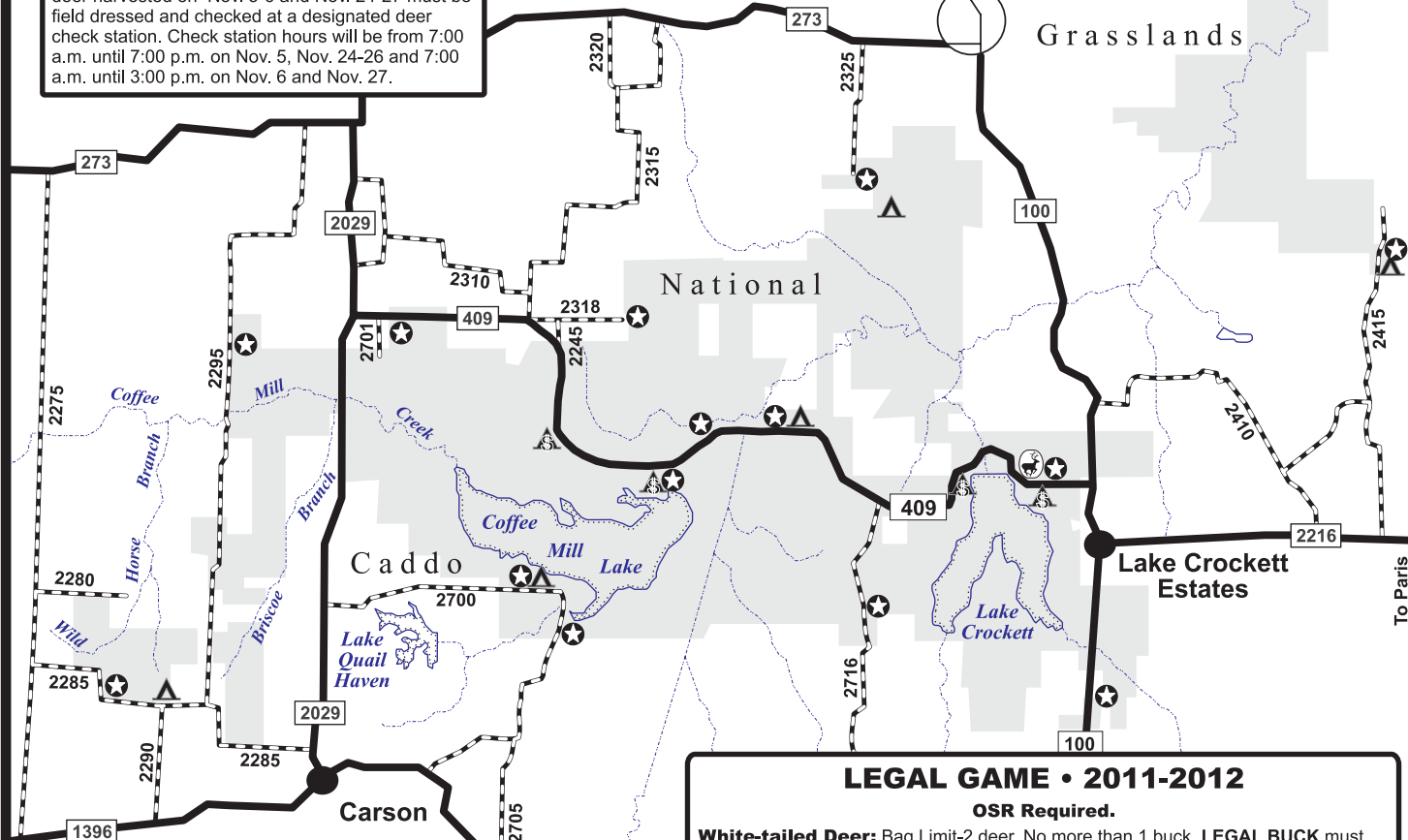

**MANDATORY DEER CHECK STATION:** All deer harvested on Nov. 5-6 and Nov. 24-27 must be field dressed and checked at a designated deer check station. Check station hours will be from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on Nov. 5, Nov. 24-26 and 7:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. on Nov. 6 and Nov. 27.



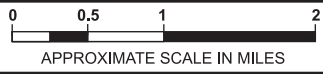

### YOUTH HUNTS

**Youth Only Squirrel/Feral Hogs:** Sept. 24-25. Shotgun and rimfire only.

**Youth Only Deer/Feral Hog:** Oct. 29-30 and Jan. 2-15 (Bag limit 1 deer, either sex). See Legal game Box for legal buck requirements. No USFS Antlerless Deer Permit required.

**Youth Only Waterfowl:** See Texas Migratory Digest for Special Youth Season information and regulations.



### LEGAL GAME • 2011-2012

**OSR Required.**

**White-tailed Deer:** Bag Limit-2 deer. No more than 1 buck. **LEGAL BUCK** must have at least one unbranched antler or an inside spread of at least 13 inches.

**Archery Only Season:** Oct. 1-28 (either sex). No USFS Antlerless Deer Permit required.

**General Season:** Nov. 5-6, 24-27 (either sex). No USFS Antlerless Deer Permit required.). Nov. 7-23, 28-Jan. 1 (buck only).

**Feral Hog:** (no bag limit).

**Archery Only Season:** Oct. 1-28.

**General Season:** Nov. 5-Mar. 11. All legal firearms, archery, and crossbows may be used to take feral hogs during this season.

**Spring Eastern Turkey:** Apr. 15-May 14 (1 gobbler only). **Shotguns, Archery, and Crossbows** only. No baiting allowed. All turkeys harvested must be tagged and taken to an Eastern Turkey check station within 24 hours.

**Waterfowl:** Shooting hours - one half hour before sunrise to noon. Hunting is allowed Wed., Sat., and Sun. during the **Early Teal, North Zone Duck, and Eastern Zone Goose** seasons.

**Woodcock, Rail, Gallinule, and Snipe**

**Dove:** Sept. 1-30.

**Squirrel, Furbearers, Rabbits & Hares:** Oct. 1-Feb. 5, May 15-31.

**Quail:** Oct. 29-Feb. 26. **Predators**

**Frogs**

**Fishing:** No permit required.

**SPECIAL REGULATIONS:** Only hunters with a permanent upper limb disability may use a crossbow to take deer and feral hog during an archery only season. Only hunters are required to possess the APH Permit. All pasture roads are closed to vehicular traffic including access by disabled users.
