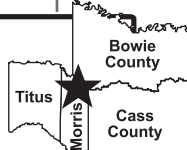


## White Oak Creek WMA Unit #727 25,777 acres

Property owned by U.S. Army Corps of Engineers



- Designated Entrance and Information Station

**NOTE:** TPWD Law Enforcement personnel in the area will be enforcing DPS regulations and decal requirements concerning ATV use on Public Hunting Lands.

**Means Restriction:** Only hunters with a permanent upper limb disability may use a crossbow to take deer and feral hog during an archery only season. Firearms are restricted to shotguns and rimfire rifles or handguns except during feral Hog General Season.

**SPECIAL REGULATIONS:** Entrance at designated entry points is required. Only hunters are required to possess the APH Permit. Waterfowl decoys may not be left set out overnight. Equestrian trails are open all year except when the entire area is closed.

**DISABLED ACCESS:** Registration at the White Oak Creek WMA Headquarters (903/884-3800) is required prior to ATV use.

**ENTIRE AREA CLOSED:** Oct. 29-30, Nov. 5-7, 9-11, Dec. 2-4, and Feb. 1-5, 8-12.

### LEGAL GAME • 2011-2012

**Archery Only White-tailed Deer Season:** Oct. 1-Jan. 1. Bag limit - 2 deer (1 buck and 1 antlerless). **LEGAL BUCK** must have at least one unbranched antler or an inside spread of at least 13 inches.

**Feral Hogs:** (no bag limit). Feral hogs may be harvested while engaged in any legal hunt, except during Spring Eastern Turkey season, provided the hunter uses the means that corresponds to that particular hunt.

**General Season:** Feb. 13-29 (use of dogs allowed). Dog identification required. Mar. 1-31 (no dogs allowed). Use of ATV's restricted to disabled hunters only. No firearm restrictions.

**Spring Eastern Turkey:** Apr. 15-May 14 (1 gobbler only). Shotgun only. No baiting allowed. All turkeys harvested must be tagged and taken to an Eastern Turkey check station within 24 hours.

**Dove:** Sept. 1-30 provided these dates fall within the season.

**Waterfowl:** Shooting hours - one half hour before sunrise to noon, except all day hunting is allowed for the Early Teal Season. Hunting is allowed each day of the **Early Teal**, and **North Zone Duck** seasons.

**Woodcock, Rails, Gallinules, and Snipe:** May be taken during the shooting hours and season dates for waterfowl during the open seasons for these species.

**Squirrel, Coyotes, Furbearers, Rabbits, and Hares:** Oct. 1-Jan. 31. Shotgun and rimfire only. Unlimited coyotes, furbearers, rabbits, and hares.

**Fishing:** No permit required while on WMA property. Local rivers and creeks are not WMA property.

**YOUTH HUNTS**  
**Youth/Adult Squirrel and Feral Hog:** Sept. 24-25. Shotguns and rimfire only. Coyotes, rabbits, and hares may also be taken.
