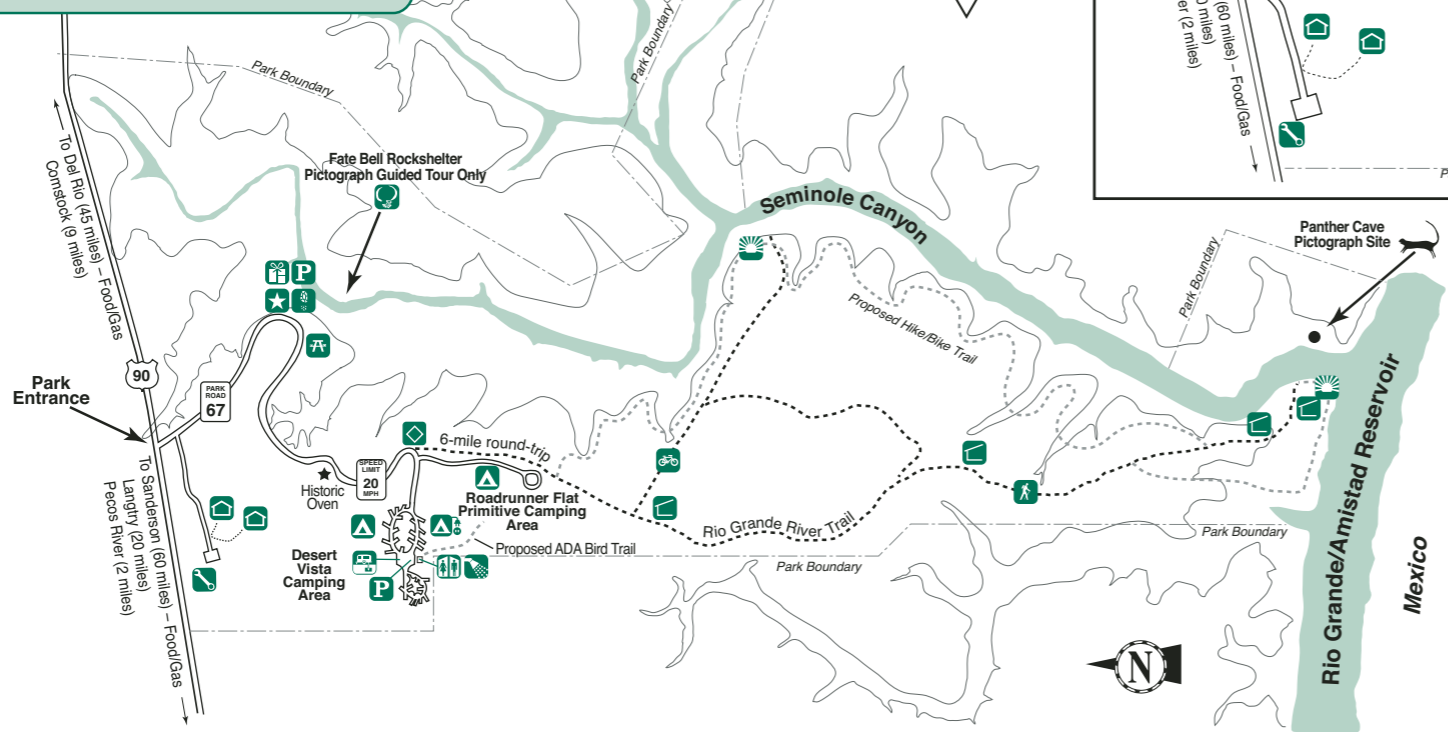
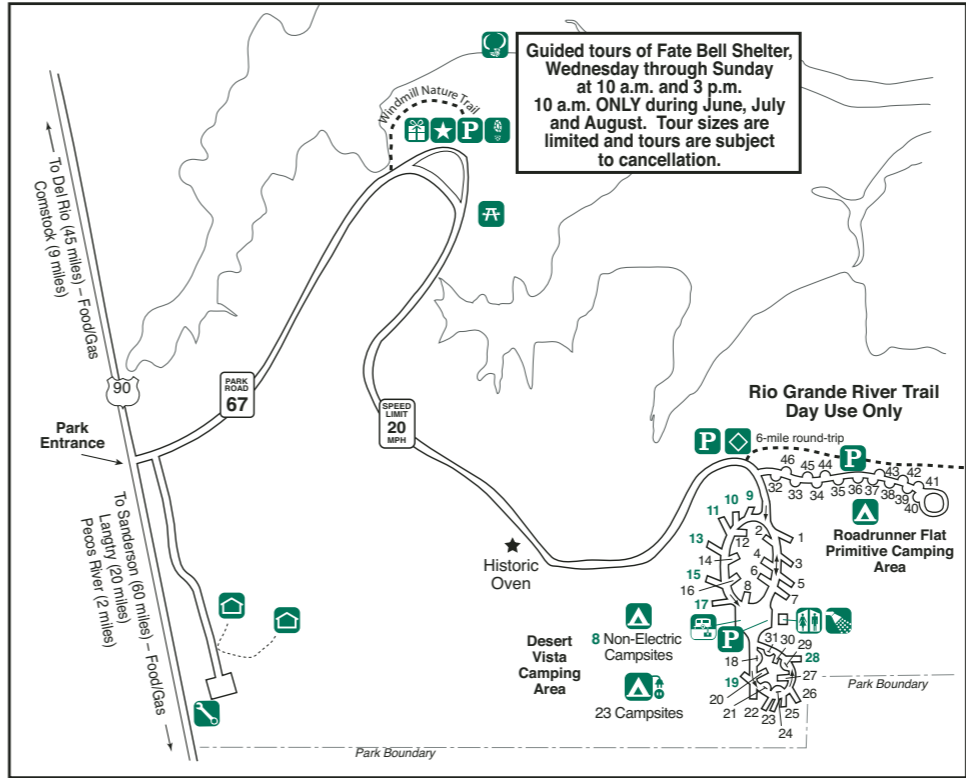


Seminole Canyon
