- Please Note:**
- CHECK OUT time is 2 p.m. or renew permit by 9 a.m. (pending site availability).
  - A maximum of eight people per campsite is permitted. Guests visiting for the day must leave the park by 10 p.m. Quiet time is from 10 p.m. – 6 a.m.
  - Park closes at 10 p.m.

- Public consumption or display of any alcoholic beverage is prohibited.
- Gathering of firewood is prohibited.
- Campfires are permitted only in fire rings provided at each site. No ground fires are permitted.
- Numbered sites are for overnight camping only. NO PICNICKING.



At the time of the Civil War, huge herds of buffalo roamed this area. A favorite buffalo run was through the gap in the Callahan Divide, near what is now the town of Buffalo Gap.

- Please Note:**
- The lake is open from sunrise to sunset.
  - Overnight camping is prohibited.
  - Canoes, kayaks and paddle boats must be rented at park headquarters prior to use.
  - Motor boats must remain at idle speed (no wake).
  - Public consumption or display of any alcoholic beverage is prohibited.
  - Gathering firewood is prohibited.
  - Campfires are permitted only in fire rings. No ground fires are permitted.
  - Abilene State Park rules and regulations apply at Lake Abilene.
