To help make everyone's camping stay safe and enjoyable, as well as protect the park and its natural beauty, please observe the following:

- CHECK OUT time is 2 p.m. or renew permit by 9 a.m. (pending site availability).
- Public consumption or display of an open container of any alcoholic beverage is prohibited.
- A maximum of 8 people permitted per campsite. Guests must leave the park by 10 p.m. Quiet time is from 10 p.m. – 6 a.m.
- An excess parking fee is required at campsites with more than two vehicles (including trailers).
- Campsite must be kept clean; all trash must be picked up before leaving. Trash cans are conveniently located on camping loop.
- GRAY WATER AND BLACK WATER MUST BE DISCHARGED ONLY AT DUMP STATIONS.
- Only one unit is permitted to hook up to utilities per site.
- Pets must be kept on leash. Please pick up after them.
- Valid permit required on windshield of each vehicle in park. All vehicles must remain on pavement.
- Numbered sites are for overnight camping only. NO PICNICKING.

Fires:

- Gathering of firewood is prohibited.
- Campfires are permitted only in fire rings provided at each site. No ground fires are permitted. Please, use extreme caution with any burning materials during the high-fire danger summer brings.

Primitive Campsites:

- Overnight camping permitted only in designated primitive camping areas. Do not rearrange the landscape with rock ramparts or windbreaks; DO NOT CONSTRUCT YOUR CAMPSITE.
- A maximum of 6 people permitted per primitive campsite.
- Campfires are not permitted in the primitive area. COOK ONLY ON CONTAINERIZED FUEL STOVES.
- Please use one of our composting toilets, if possible. Otherwise completely bury it in active topsoil not deeper than 10 inches below the surface. Completely cover your waste.
